



The <u>SISTERS</u> project aims to reduce food loss and waste in the main stages of the Food Value Chain in Europe through innovations targeted to each stage of the chain: New tools for primary producers for promoting direct and Short Chain sales; new technological innovations in packaging for processors and retailers; and awareness campaigns for retailers and consumers on food loss and waste. It will be a key EU project addressing the problem in a holistic way, reducing Food Loss & Waste by 27.4% and CO2 emissions by around 20% in the case studies.

The SISTERS project started on November 1st, 2021 and is set to end on April 30th, 2026 (4.5 years). The consortium is formed by 18 partners and 3 linked third parties from 8 different European countries: Spain, Italy, France, Belgium, Sweden, Croatia, Ireland and Switzerland.
